OIL AND GAS PRODUCERS

This category includes companies engaged in upstream activities. Membership dues are based on total production equal to the gross amount of oil produced (in barrels) plus gross gas production (in million cubic feet per day converted to curde barrel equivalent) between September 1 and August 31 each year as they are reported to and by the North Dakota Department of Mineral Resources.

Crude oil transport is measured in barrels of oil per day and natural gas is measured in million cubic feet per day.
